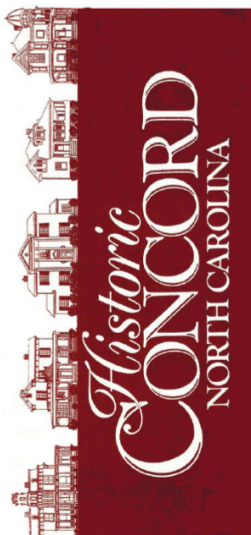

RHC uses the proceeds from events and membership to support initiatives aligned with RHC goals, including local grants for beautification, improvement, and educational programs.
